

Your Families Foundation Starts With You! - Week 1 Sermon Notes

Matthew 7: 24 "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.25The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock.26But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand.27The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash."

A healthy, Christ-centered home begins with a healthy, Christ-centered <u>human</u>.

The bulk of influence we have on our family is usually **modeled**, not necessarily taught.

It's **caught** not **taught**.

Most of what children learn from us is what they see **modeled**.

Everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand.

Barna reports that (hypocrisy) ranks as the primary reason people doubt Christianity when surveying people of "no faith" or "other faith" **AND ESPECIALLY THE 67%**".

Many times we don't doubt God but we do doubt those that <u>claim</u> to follow him.

Acts 10:2 describes Cornelius as "a devout man who feared God with all his household, gave alms generously to the people, and prayed continually to God".

Is your house built on a strong foundation?

A faith that's <u>lived</u> is a faith that <u>lasts</u>.
